Approximately 200 feet north of Whipple Road and approximately 460 feet east of the intersection of Whipple Road and Town Farm Road at Utility Poles No. 17, & 19, Assessor's Plat 122, Lot 7, Whipple Road, Burrillville, RI

Dear Mr. Fullum:

Kindly be advised that the Department of Environmental Management's ("DEM") Freshwater Wetlands Program ("Program") has completed its review of your **Request to verify the delineated edge of freshwater wetlands**. This review included an inspection of the above referenced property ("subject property") as described by the site plans submitted with your application and received on March 8, 2007.

Based upon the Program's observations and review, it is our determination that freshwater wetlands are present on or are in close proximity to the subject property. These freshwater wetlands are regulated by this Department and include at least the following types:

- swamp
- perimeter wetland (that area of land within 50 feet of the edge of any bog, marsh, swamp, or pond)

The DEM has completed an inspection and review of the wetland edges delineated by you on-site. It is our determination that those wetland edges delineated on-site are substantially accurate. Corrections and/or modifications to the delineated edge are required, however, which include the following:

- Wetland flag A-2 must be relocated 25 feet northwest.
- Wetland flag A-3 must be relocated 30 feet northwest.
- Future submissions must depict the 50-foot perimeter wetland associated with this portion of the swamp.

Please note that flags A-8 to A-10 are located off the subject parcel and were not verified.


**This letter does not constitute an approval or permit for any proposed project on the subject property. Pursuant to Section 2-1-21(a) of the Freshwater Wetlands Act and the Rules and Regulations Governing the Administration and Enforcement of the Freshwater Wetlands Act (Rules) a permit is required from this Program prior to the commencement of any activity which impacts or alters freshwater wetlands**

In addition, you should note that freshwater wetlands are present on this property that may be regulated under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended 33 U.S.C. 1344). Accordingly, a permit may be required from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for alteration of these wetland areas.

In accordance with Rule 9.02(F) of the Rules, this verification of the delineated edge of freshwater wetlands is valid for a limited period of four (4) years from the date of issue.
