Approximately 300 feet east of Prospect Avenue, approximately 600 feet north of the intersection of Prospect Avenue and Summit Avenue, Plat 1 Lot 61, Jamestown, RI.

Dear Mr. Dutton:

Kindly be advised that the Department of Environmental Management's ("DEM") Freshwater Wetlands Program ("Program") has completed its review of your **Request to verify the delineated edge of freshwater wetlands**. This review included an inspection of the above referenced property ("subject property") as described by the site plans submitted with your application and received on April 9, 2007.

Based upon the Program's observations and review, it is our determination that freshwater wetlands are present on or are in close proximity to the subject property. These freshwater wetlands are regulated by this Program and include at least the following types:

- Swamp
- 50-foot Perimeter Wetland
- (2) Areas Subject to Storm Flowage (ASSF)

The DEM has completed an inspection and review of the wetland edge delineated by you on-site. It is our determination that the wetland edge delineated on-site is partially accurate. This wetland edge has been shown on the site plan submitted with your application and is referenced as wetland flags A6 through A11. These wetland edge flags delineate the edge of a swamp. Corrections and/or modifications to the delineated edge are required which include the following:

- Relocate wetland flag A7 approximately 20 feet to the east.
- Relocate wetland flag A9 approximately 40 feet to the southwest.

Other than these corrections, all other wetland edges illustrated by the "A" series flags are considered accurate.

Please note that two Areas Subject to Storm Flowage (ASSF) were identified on site entering the wetland in the general vicinity of wetland flags A9 and A10. These ASSFs were not shown on the site plan, but should be depicted on any future site plans.


Please note that our inspection of the subject property has revealed the presence of other freshwater wetlands not specifically delineated by you. Therefore, you should not infer that any verification of wetland edges carried out by this Department to date represents a determination that this is the extent of all wetlands on your property. **The Department has verified only those edges delineated and shown by you on-site and on site plans submitted with your application and as qualified in this letter.** Should you wish to verify the edge of these additional wetlands, an additional application will be required.

**This letter does not constitute an approval or permit for any proposed project on the subject property. Pursuant to Section 2-1-21(a) of the Freshwater Wetlands Act and the Rules and Regulations Governing the Administration and Enforcement of the Freshwater Wetlands Act (Rules) a permit is required from this Program prior to the commencement of any activity which impacts or alters freshwater wetlands**

In accordance with Rule 9.02(F) of the Rules, this verification of the delineated edge of freshwater wetlands is valid for a limited period of four (4) years from the date of issue.
