Approximately 620 feet southeast of Fish Road, approximately 2000 feet northeast of the intersection of Fish Road and Eagleville Road, Utility Pole No. 36, Assessor's Plat 105, Lot 101, Tiverton, RI.

Dear Mr. Felise:

Kindly be advised that the Department of Environmental Management's ("DEM") Freshwater Wetlands Program ("Program") has completed its review of your **Request to verify the delineated edge of freshwater wetlands**. This review included an inspection of the above referenced property ("subject property") as described by the site plans submitted with your application and received on September 11, 2012.

Based upon the Program's observations and review, it is our determination that freshwater wetlands are present on or are in close proximity to the subject property. These freshwater wetlands are regulated by this Program and include at least the following types:

- Swamp
- 50-foot Perimeter Wetland
- Area Subject to Storm Flowage (ASSF)

The DEM has completed an inspection and review of the wetland edges delineated by you on-site. These wetland edges have been shown on the site plan submitted with your application and are referenced as wetland flags B1 through B45 and C1 through C24. These wetland edge flags delineate portions of the edges of a swamp.

It is our determination that the wetland edges delineated on-site are substantially accurate, but require some modifications. Corrections and/or modifications to the delineated edge are required which include the following:

- Relocate Flag B2 approximately 10 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B3 approximately 8 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B4 approximately 15 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B5 approximately 15 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B6 approximately 20 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B7 approximately 20 feet to the southeast,

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30% post-consumer fiber

- Relocate Flag B8 approximately 16 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B9 approximately 20 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B10 approximately 32 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B11 approximately 20 feet to the east,
- Relocate Flag B17 approximately 8 feet to the west,
- Relocate Flag B31 approximately 8 feet to the west,
- Relocate Flag B37 approximately 6 feet to the southwest.
- Relocate flag C1 approximately 20 feet slightly north of east.
- Relocate flag C2 approximately 16 feet to the east.
- Relocate flag C3 approximately 12 feet to the east.
- Relocate flag C22 approximately 4 feet to the west.
- Relocate flag C23 approximately 16 feet to the west.
- Relocate flag C24 approximately 8 feet to the west.

Other than these corrections, all other wetland edges illustrated by the "B" and "C" series flags are considered accurate. The Area Subject to Storm Flowage was not verified under this application.

Please note that our inspection of the subject property has revealed the presence of other freshwater wetlands not specifically delineated by you. Therefore, you should not infer that any verification of wetland edges carried out by this Department to date represents a determination that this is the extent of all wetlands on your property. **The Department has verified only those edges delineated and shown by you on-site and on site plans submitted with your application and as qualified in this letter.** Should you wish to verify the edge of these additional wetlands, an additional application will be required.

This letter does not constitute an approval or permit for any proposed project on the subject property. Pursuant to Section 2-1-21(a) of the Freshwater Wetlands Act and the Rules and Regulations Governing the Administration and Enforcement of the Freshwater Wetlands Act (Rules) a permit is required from this Program prior to the commencement of any activity which impacts or alters freshwater wetlands.

This Program assumes that the edges of freshwater wetlands, as flagged or marked on site, have been accurately surveyed and portrayed on site plans submitted in support of your application. This Program makes no guarantee or representation that such survey is accurate.

In addition, you should note that freshwater wetlands are present on this property that may be regulated under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended 33 U.S.C. 1344). Accordingly, a permit may be required from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for alteration of these wetland areas.


