Approximately 70 feet South of Frigate Street, Utility Pole 20, approximately 515 feet east of its intersection with Seaside Drive, Assessor's Plat 16, Lot 222, Jamestown, RI

Dear Ms. Geremia:

Kindly be advised that the Department of Environmental Management's ("DEM") Freshwater Wetlands Program ("Program") has completed its review of your **Request to verify the delineated edge of freshwater wetlands**. This review included an inspection of the above referenced property ("subject property") as described by the site plans submitted with your application and received on October 27, 2014.

Based upon the Program's observations and review, it is our determination that freshwater wetlands are present on or are in close proximity to the subject property. These freshwater wetlands are regulated by this Department and include at least the following types:

- forested wetland (off site to the south and east)
- stream/intermittent stream (off site to the east)
- riverbank wetland (the area of land within 100 feet of the edge of any flowing body of water less than 10 feet wide)
- Floodplain (associated with the stream; no elevation has been determined, so there is no way to confirm at this time whether or not floodplain extends onto the subject property)


The DEM has completed an inspection and review of the wetland edge delineated by you on-site. It is our determination that the wetland east of the subject lot is a forested wetland and does not require a perimeter wetland as depicted on the submitted site plans. The forested wetland does not encroach onto the subject property. However, a stream is present approximately eighty (80) feet east of the northeast property corner and the riverbank wetland extends onto the northeast portion of the subject lot.

**This letter does not constitute an approval or permit for any proposed project on the subject property. Pursuant to Section 2-1-21(a) of the Freshwater Wetlands Act and the Rules and Regulations Governing the Administration and Enforcement of the Freshwater Wetlands Act (Rules) a permit is required from this Program prior to the commencement of any activity which impacts or alters freshwater wetlands**

In accordance with Rule 8.03(H) of the Rules, this verification of the delineated edge of freshwater wetlands is valid for a limited period of four (4) years from the date of issue.
